Whites

- 1. Panul Sauvignon Blanc Vinedos Marchigue 2009 Chile** £13.00
A dry fresh Sauvignon with an attractive herbaceous quality. Super white wine from this great Chilean estate.
- 2. Petite Gasconne Blanc Producteurs Plaimont VdP du Gers 2009 France** £13.00
Medium dry white wine with fresh fruit flavours and crisp acidity, blended in Gascony by this respected producer.
- 3. Lowry's Pass Chenin Blanc 2009 South Africa** £14.00
Modern South African Chenin Blanc. Light, zesty and equally enjoyable with food or on its own.
- 4. Riesling Schloss Schonborn 2009 Rheingau Germany** £14.00
A super single estate Riesling, a very typical German medium to medium sweet floral light white wine.
- 5. Santa Florentina Organic Chardonnay Famatina Valley 2008 Argentina** £14.00
Ultra fresh, this unoaked Fairtrade Chardonnay is clean and light, with ripe fruit, and delicate floral notes.
- 6. Pinot Grigio Luna Cecilia Beretta 2009 Italy** £15.00
Delicate and fresh with exceptional balance, this Pinot Grigio is leagues above the rest.
- 7. Ana Sauvignon Blanc 2008 Marlborough, New Zealand** £18.00
From the Atwere Valley know for its own micro climate giving a fresh herb notes, sprightly, with rich and leafy notes.
- 8. Chardonnay Nelson Estate 2009, South Africa** £22.00
Rich and creamy Chardonnay with subtle oak flavours, beautifully made at the award winning Nelson Estate.

Rose

- 9. La Brouette Rose Producteurs Plaimont VdP du Comte Tolosan 2008 France** £13.00
This rosé offers layers of fresh strawberries and cream with supple tannins and lively acidity.
- 10. Rose Nelson Estate 2010 Paarl, South Africa** £17.00
Lisha Nelson's inaugural vintage at her father's Paarl wine farm has scooped her several awards in wine competitions worldwide. This Cabernet-Merlot rosé shows exactly why, with its delicate red fruit, creamy texture, fine acidity and structure.
- 11. Sparkling Rose Le Colture Brut NV, Italy** £19.00
Made by prestigious Le Colture family estate, this hand-made wine is the perfect party pink!

Reds

- 12. Panul Merlot Vinedos Marchigue Colchagua Valley 2009, Chile** £13.00
Easy drinking, rich and juicy Merlot from the idyllic Colchagua Valley in Central Chile.
- 13. El Campasino, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2009, Chile** £13.00
Lovely black fruits and light tannins make for a balanced glass of wine from this popular part of the world.
- 14. Shiraz Heywood Estate 2009, South East Australia** £16.00
The fruit of these old vines is rich and concentrated, producing a wine with spicy dark berries, baked plum and hints of pepper.
- 15. Altos de Baroja Rioja Joven 2008, Spain** £18.00
Benchmark, youthful style Rioja offering great value for money. Made in the classic mould, but with bags of modern appeal.
- 16. Pinot Noir Reserva Vina Mar 2009, Casablanca, Chile** £18.00
Viña Mar's state-of-the-art winery in Casablanca produces wines of superb value for money and consistency. spicy and ripe fruited, yet retains an elegance thanks to the vineyard's proximity to the Pacific.
- 17. Pinotage Rhebokskloof 2008, Paarl, South Africa** £19.00
A fresh, elegant expression of idiosyncratic Pinotage grape from the classic Rhebokskloof Estate.
- 18. Chateau Musar 1997, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon** £27.00
A truly iconic vineyard! A hint of spice and leather combined in this wine, with a streak of volatile acidity. Rich red wine with plenty of substance on the palate and drinking perfectly at the moment.

Champagne & Sparkling Wines

- 19. Guy de Chasse, Grand Cru Brut NV Champagne, France** £32.00
This House Champagne is 100% Grand cru! Fantastic value for money from this small family owned House.
- 20. Dellamotte Rose, Grand Cru NV Champagne, France** £43.00
A blend of 80% Pinot Noir and 20% Chardonnay from Grand Cru vineyards. Delamotte still produces its rose by the 'saignee' method, a highly-skilled technique. Elegance and finesse with appealing wild strawberry fruit.
- 21. Asti Spumante, Martini, South Piedmont, Italy NV** £15.00
Medium Sweet, refreshing grapey fruit. A really well known classic and easy drinking sparkling wine.
- 22. Charles de St Ceran Brut NV Vin Moussant, France** £15.00
A very good dry pre-dinner drink, during, after or at anytime!
